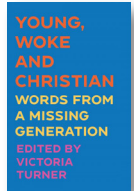
Sacraments After Christendom, by Janet Sutton and Andrew Francis

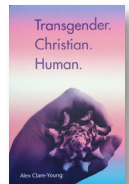
Young, Woke And Christian

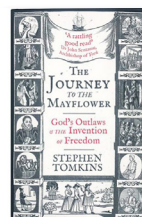
The Fire Still Burns, by Stuart Scott

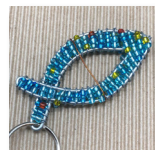
Handmade Glass Cross And Fish
